Tell -El -Amarna

Akhenaton had decided to unify the multi gods to the worship of one god, the sun god, Aten. Tell El Amarna is where the ruins of the city that was constructed by Akhenaton and his wife Queen Nefertiti built there city to be the center of the cult of the sun god, Aten.



El-Ashmunein

During the Old Kingdom the town was of great importance as a cult centre of Thoth, god of wisdom . There are two famous colossal baboon statues and a restored Coptic basilica.

Tuna El Gebel

Was the necropolis of the city of Ashmunein, sacred to the Greek god Hermes and his Egyptian counterpart Thoth. There are multitudes of ibises and baboons

Necropoli di Beni Hassan

This necropolis is called Beni Hasan and it was established and used to burry the dead bodies of the provinces rulers during the Middle Kingdom. The Necropolis of Beni Hassan hosts a large number of tombs that contain attractive decorations and layout with exciting themes and everlasting brightful colors.
