Luxor (Esna) / Aswan Every Friday

1° day Luxor /Esna

- Arrival to Luxor from Cairo
- Meeting our local guide of your preferred language. Then assist guests to follow the entry Procedures at the airport..
- Transfer to Dahabeya (Cat. 5 stars) on full board for 07 nights.
- Accommodation in cabins reserved.
- Time is dedicated to the visit of the wonderful Temple of Karnak, dedicated to the god Amun, the most important and largest religious center of ancient Egypt. Lunch at restaurant . Visit the Temple of Luxor, a beautiful masterpiece, Return on board .
- Dinner and overnight.



2° day Esna/Edfu

- Full Board
- Visit the magnificent Valley of the Kings on the western bank of the Nile ; the largest necropolis in Egypt, & then visit one of the most original and beautiful temples, is the temple of Queen Hatshepsut. Stop to admire the Colossus of Memnon. Reboarding and lunch on board. After sail to el Hagz Island Dinner and Overnight



3° day Edfu/ Kom Ombo

- Full Board
- Sail to Edfu, time is dedicated to the visit of the temple of the god Horus, one of the best preserved temples of Egypt.
- After the tour, Return to the ship, to continue sailing to Farris Island. Dinner on board and overnight .



4° day Kom Ombo / Aswan

- Full Board.
- In the morning, sail to Kom Ombo, after the arrival, visit the Temple of Kom Ombo dedicated to two gods: the god Sobek, god of fertility with the crocodile-headed & God Haroeris, the God of sun-headed hawk. After the visit, embarkation and continue sailing to Aswan. Dinner and overnight on board.

- Arrive in Aswan ; the southernmost city of Egypt as a holiday resort thanks to its mild climate, the city offers its visitors strong emotions.
- Morning visit the High Dam & Philae Temple. Dinner and overnight.

**** Optional Excursions: Discovering Abu Simbel

- Visit the fabulous mortuary temple built during the reign of Ramses II. The four colossal statues of the Pharaoh seated on his throne were carved in the rock, on a front 38 meters wide and 65 deep.
- Reboarding. Dinner and overnight on board
